## Ski Lessons - Beginners and Improvers

## **Day Membership**

Adult £15      Student/Junior £10

You are entitled to ski for the duration of the session on the date of membership.

Not entitled to vote. Will not receive a newsletter.

If this membership is converted to Full membership within 1 month £10 per adult or £5 per student/junior will be taken off the cost of membership.

## **Ski /boarding levels required for Membership.**

Recreational skiers must ski in control and be capable of performing snowplough turns.

Boarders will need to demonstrate full turns – a ‘falling leaf’ is not sufficient.

All members must be able to control both their speed and direction.

## **Group Bookings**

For group bookings of 8 or more outside busy times it is £5 per 1½ hour session for juniors and £10 for adults.

We aim to suit individual or group requirements. Please give the centre a call for further details.

**Note:** All prices include ski equipment. However, you will be required to bring a pair of gloves and always wear long sleeves. You are recommended to wear long socks and waterproof trousers or tracksuit bottoms that are wide enough to go over the boots.

**Funpark** – there are specific requirements to use the Funpark see separate sheet.

## **Lessons and Instructors**

Our team of volunteer ski instructors is qualified and registered with Snowsport England.

For beginners we operate a programme of ski instruction taking the form of four 1.5-hour lessons over a three-week period (6 x 1 hour lessons for juniors 6-8 years old and 4 x 1.5 hour lessons aged 8 -18). These aim to take beginners from never putting a pair of skis on their feet to a snowplough turning standard and the ability to use the ski tow, thus enabling them to use the slope safely for recreational skiing. These courses must be booked in advance, please call for availability.

We also run intermediate lessons, these are 1.5-hour lessons aimed at eliminating bad habits and improving your technical skiing ability which will allow you to cope with more varied ski conditions. Again, these need to be booked in advance.

Please note that all lessons need to be booked and paid for in advance via the telephone (01782 784908) when the club is open or in person at the ski centre.

No lesson bookings can be taken on-line or via email.
