The Snowlife Snowsport Awards are nationally recognised awards for skiing and snowboarding. They've been developed by UK Governing Bodies for skiing and snowboarding and BASI (British Association of Snowsport Instructors). So, it really means something when you win one.

On Sunday May 18th the Kids Club will be running their first Snow Life Awards Assessment day.

Sunday mornings prior to this date, we will be going over the necessary tasks and skills required.

Each child will be tested on the level they are currently working towards together with the previous level. This means that on the first Assessment day they will be sure to complete at least one of the two set levels. At a later date there will be an awards day where the children will be presented with a medal and certificate.

If your children wish to be involved in this assessment day, it's important that they register with Simon or Phil so that they can be tested and entered into the relevant award level. Obviously its important that they can attend as many kids club sessions as possible prior to the day.

We believe that the Snow Life Awards are a great way of assessing your child's skiing progress and gives them set goals that they can aim for.
