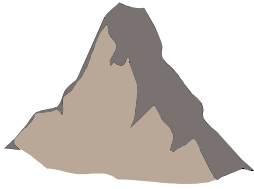

The Resort



Set in the Southern Alps, Serre Chevalier is one of France's most underrated ski resorts, with 250kms of superb runs.

Serre Chevalier comprises a collection of over a dozen villages including Chantemerle, Villeneuve, Monetier-les-Bains and the ancient town of Briançon which are all linked by ski-bus. Four of the villages are connected by ski runs and an efficient lift system. The whole area enjoys long hours of sunshine and is close enough to the Italian border for day trips to the Milky Way. Its good weather record combines with an extensive skiing area to offer an excellent holiday for all types of skier. The main skiing is in the large bowls reached by the cablecar and gondolas from Chantemerle, Villeneuve and Briançon.

Our accommodation is located in Villeneuve. If you are looking for extensive high altitude skiing, plenty of sunshine, spectacular mountain scenery and value for money, then Serre Chevalier is for you.

Beginners: There is a vast array of cruising blues that novices and snow-ploughers will enjoy – perfect for practicing those important first turns.

Intermediate: Intermediates of all levels will get the best out of a Serre Chevalier ski holiday. Blues and reds cover the whole area giving that enjoyable sense of journey. There's a fantastic variety of intermediate runs from wide motorways, challenging reds winding through the forest and fast schusses but without the danger of accidentally going off piste!

Advanced: Ski holidays in Serre Chevalier give advanced skiers loads of challenging reds, long blacks and tough mogul fields as well as virtually unlimited off-piste through hidden valleys and glades.

Serre Chevalier Snowboarding

Serre Chevalier snowboarding offers superb terrain at Monetier in particular. It's a snowboarder's heaven! Serre Chevalier is like one big adventure park, there's so much variety, with lots of long tree runs, the 200 metres long Aravet half pipe and the snowboard cross, a run with 7 turns fitted and a vertical drop, you will always be kept busy.

The Hotel



The property is ideally situated right on a piste with guaranteed snow. Beginners can practice on the nursery slope by the hotel or walk for 5-6 minutes to the Frejus lift to be taken to a wide selection of slopes to start off from. More advanced skiers can ski for 2 minutes down to the Pontillas gondola and be taken straight up to the ski area. A red run or a ride in a gondola takes you back to the hotel. In the evening it is a short walk to Villeneuve, which is a lively, traditional village with a range of excellent shops, bars and restaurants offering fantastic local mountain specialties.

The Grand Aigle is officially a 2 star but its diverse range of public areas and facilities give guests both a comfortable and fun stay. There are two large restaurants and a comfortable lounge on the lower ground floor. Guests have the choice of two bars within the hotel – the entertaining “Sports Bar” or the relaxing, traditional “Cave Bar” with a very welcoming open log fire.
