We have now completed 3 years with the new matting and it has performed far beyond our expectations. So much so, that this year we have had to do very little maintenance on the slope.

Club membership seems to have stabilized at around the 1,000 mark. This is made up of Junior, Adult and Family memberships.

The Friday night Instructor Training has continued and more instructors gained qualifications.

The social events organised by the club have also been well attended this year. Over 100 people went on the club holiday in January to Chatel, in the Portes du Soleil. This year we flew from Manchester to Grenoble, with a three hour transfer by coach from Grenoble to Chatel. We were blessed with a week of sunshine, however the snow cover was getting a little thin by the end of the week.

Next years club holiday will be in the French resort of Serre Chevalier. Booking was a little slow to start, but there are now over 75 people on this holiday.

Our financial policy is one of careful management and investment. Expenditure is tightly controlled to ensure that our income is spent wisely. We pay our bills promptly and claim any discounts that are offered.
