#### Ski Helmets Should Fit Correctly.

All those under 18 using our slope must wear a helmet. They are

available in the foyer.

**Fitting Your Head --** A ski helmet needs to be comfortable and snug. If you can swish the helmet around when you move your head from side to side or back to front, it is too big for you. At the same time, your helmet can't be too tight. It will be no good to you if the helmet cuts the circulation off to your brain. The helmet needs to be fastened properly too - make sure the strap is not dangling loosely below your chin ready to get blown off. There is a pictorial guide on the wall in the foyer.

**On warm days on our slope** be aware that your child's head can easily become overheated. We know they don't want to have a break from skiing, but it is advisable that at regular intervals they stop for a drink and a short time in the shade without their helmet on.



Membership cards must be shown on arrival. If you do not have a membership card please bring a

passport sized photo on your first visit so that you can be issued with one. Please sign in on arrival.

The card should also have details of your ski length, boot size and din setting. If it does not, ask at reception or complete the form on page 4 and bring it to the club.

## **RECREATIONAL SKIERS - A REMINDER**



For the safety and enjoyment of all our members please remember that the ski way code should be adhered to at **ALL** times. Failure to do so will result in you being asked to leave the slope.

**ALL** slope users should be performing linked turns and be in control at **ALL** times.

A copy of the Skiway Code is on display in the clubhouse.

Netting and safety barriers are for your safety and **NOT** as an alternative method of stopping.

#### NSSC code of conduct

- 1. Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all other slope users regardless of age, ability, gender, race, ethnicity, religious belief, sexuality or social/economic status.
- 2. Control your speed.
- 3. Give way to users ahead of you and choose a route that will not endanger or alarm them.
- 4. Leave plenty of room when overtaking.
- 5. If you have to stop do so at the side of the slope, the run out at the bottom should be clear at all times. This is not a spectator area or a place to store equipment.
- 6. Look up and down the slope before setting off.
- 7. You should not walk on the slope. If you have to do this it should be up or down the sides.
- 8. In the event of an accident all activity must stop. Everyone is duty bound to assist and witnesses must provide relevant information.
- North Staffs Ski Club reserves the right to ask you to leave the slope if you are considered by a Club Official/Instructor not to be abiding by the above Code of Conduct or Slope Rules.
