New Series of World Cup Skiing on Channel 4

SKI SKILLS—Fundamental skills of ski technique:

When changing direction you need to use the following skills:

To stay in **BALANCE**

To use **SKI EDGES**

To **TURN** the skis

To apply changes of weight **PRESSURE**,

“The principle is that every skier when making any change of direction irrespective of ability must apply these three skills to their skis without losing balance”. (Ski Technique & Instruction Manual. Book 2)
