

There are currently further rooms available at the hotel and if there are more people interested we will go back to Thomsons to see if we can extend the booking.

Slope development update.

Not much has changed visually since the last newsletter but things have been going on in the background.

A request went in to Newcastle Borough Council to extend the licence to use the park road as access, I am pleased to say they have agreed to the extension to cover the completion of Phase 1. Meetings have been held to discuss possible variations in terrain on the slope to provide added challenges for intermediate skiers. Nothing has yet been decided and you will have the opportunity to discuss proposals before those decisions are made.

Currently we are waiting for companies to tender for the completion of Phase 1.

Work has continued towards securing additional funding for the project with an "Expression of Interest" Application for a grant being submitted to BIFFA.
