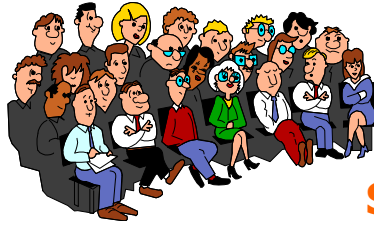




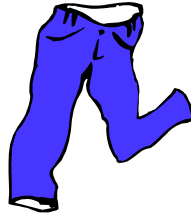

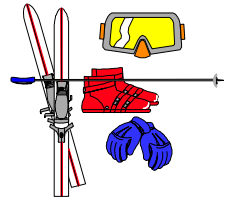
The club will be closed for skiing on this night to allow volunteers to attend. A draft financial statement will be available at the ski club from 8th October 2013 and at the meeting.

Previously we announced that there would be a working party to plant almost 1000 trees and shrubs which will provide a green interface to disguise the palling fence. You may be glad to hear that this autumn we will be planting only around 800 Hawthorns as the others will be planted next year.

If you have one could you please bring a planting (ladies) spade. At the same time people are needed to finish off the application of anti vandal paint on top of the palling fence. If it is raining we will continue with the planting but we will not be able to do the painting.

MASTERCLASS IS BACK!

MASTERCLASS HAS CHANGED TO MONDAY NIGHTS



- Are you looking to improve your ski technique?
- Have you hit a plateau and wondering how to take your skiing to the next level?
- Are you looking to get your ski legs back for your next skiing holiday?
- Are you thinking about becoming an instructor?
- Are you looking for a fresh challenge?

If the answer to any of the questions above is yes then maybe Masterclass is for you!

Run by the club's coaches, Masterclass is for intermediate to advanced skiers who are looking to improve their skiing ability. The session works on improving the foundations of ski technique (balance, stance, body management etc.) which in turn will improve personal performance.

This season the sessions will take place every Monday evening from 7pm –9pm.

The cost to members is £5 per session. Payment for the session is to be made prior to taking part. Non-members are welcome. Please ask at the club for details of cost.

Please note: minimum requirement for the class is the ability to ski parallel. For more information contact the club or come down and give it a try!

Slope Development Update.

**Have you seen it?
It looks quite different now.**

The ground has been re sculptured and the fencing has been completed around the perimeter.

People have come forward with ideas to make the new area fun, functional, and challenging. With those ideas in mind the ground has been sculptured to enable the new tow to be placed to the left of the old tow (looking from the bottom). This means that there will be room to extend the existing slope to incorporate features which will challenge the intermediate skier.

On the other side of the new tow, to encourage younger members to stay with the club and therefore provide future committee members, it is proposed to put a Snowpark incorporating jumps and rails. Feedback from both older and younger members of the club has been positive with many of the older ones dying to have a go on the Snowpark.



An open meeting is planned for Saturday 30th November from 1pm when we will have on display a proposed design for the new slope with your ideas incorporated where possible. So come along and see for yourself what we are

trying to achieve.

The work has continued preparing information for the requests for additional funding. An application has been submitted to BIFFA for a grant.

Talks are continuing with Newcastle Under Lyme Borough Council, Snowsport England, County Sports Partnership and the club on the preparation of a bid for funding from Sport England.

As was mentioned in previous newsletter's something which will act in our favour when applying for extra funding is if we can show that the club members are supporting the project by giving a donation specifically towards the project fund.

So, can you help your club by donating a small or large amount to go directly into the project fund? If you feel you would like to donate please give it to someone behind the ski counter. If all our adult members donated £10 we would raise £5,000. If you are a tax payer then it can be gift aided to mean more. Just ask for a form at the ski club. Remember, the club is run entirely by volunteers which is why it is the cheapest skiing in the country. We need your support to improve your skiing experience at Kidsgrove!
