## **Ski /boarding levels required for Membership.**

Recreational skiers must ski in control and be capable of performing snowplough turns.

Boarders will need to demonstrate full turns – a ‘falling leaf’ is not sufficient.

All members must be able to control both their speed and direction.

## **Group Bookings**

For group bookings of 8 or more outside busy times it is £5 per 1½ hour session for juniors and £10 for adults.

We aim to suit individual or group requirements. Please give the centre a call for further details.

**Note:** All prices include ski equipment. However, you will be required to bring a pair of gloves and wear long sleeves at all times. You are recommended to wear long socks and waterproof trousers or tracksuit bottoms that are wide enough to go over the boots.

## **Lessons and Instructors**

Our team of volunteer ski instructors is qualified and registered with Snowsport England.

For beginners we operate a programme of ski instruction taking the form of three 1.5 hour lessons over a three week period (4 x 1 hour lessons for juniors under 11). These aim to take beginners from never putting a pair of skis on their feet to a snowplough turning standard and the ability to use the ski tow, thus enabling them to use the slope safely for recreational skiing.
