For those of you able to help with maintenance the club will be open each Wednesday evening throughout June, July and August. Please come along and join in. Many hands make light work!!!

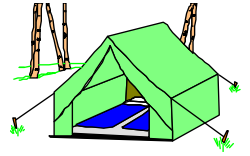

DIRECTIONS: Follow the A53 from Newcastle to Market Drayton/Shrewsbury. On approach to Shrewsbury at a roundabout take a left onto the A49 for Leominster (Shrewsbury bypass). As you approach Church Stretton you will come to a set of traffic lights, go straight through. Continue down the A49 and take the 1st right (about 2 miles), which takes you over a narrow bridge to crossroads. Go straight across by the side of the Ragleth pub and follow the narrow road round to the right crossing a ford. The site is situated on the right.
