Members - Just a reminder

We are having a check on memberships so you will be asked to show your membership card when you get your skis. If you haven't got a membership card just take a passport photo to the desk. Don't forget you can get 10% (sometimes 20%) discount from Blacks and High Peak shop in Hanley with your card.

If you are an Associate Member you must pay £8 for 1 hour or £12 for 2 hours when you come for a ski and you must show your membership card.

Parents please remember that a responsible adult should accompany junior members at all times.

Skiway Code

- 1. When you start skiing always look up and down the slope to see if it is clear.
- Always stop at the sides of the slope not in the middle.
- 3. Always behave sensibly on the slope.
- **4.** Do not ski too fast, especially if the slope is busy.
- **5.** Leave lots of room if you want to ski past somebody. If anyone falls and is hurt tell an instructor.

Don't forget.

If you bring a friend to recreational ski they must join as an Associate Member and it is only available to those skiers who can perform basic snowplough turns and controlled stops. Any skiers found unable to make these basic manoeuvres will be asked to leave the slope. No refunds will be given.

Also

Please don't bring valuables to be left in the club house whilst you are skiing. There is no secure place to keep them, many people go in and out of the ski room. Any thing left is at your own risk.
